Complacency of Continuity

- Legalism / pride: up to us to save the world
- Lusts: indulge own desires (Jude 1:18-19)
- Laziness: when Master is away (Mt 24:45-51)

In the last time there will be scoffers, following their own ungodly passions.

It is these who cause divisions, worldly people, devoid of the Spirit.

Jude 1:18-19 (ESV)

Who then is the **faithful** and **wise** servant, whom the master has put in **charge** of the servants in his household ...?

It will be good for that servant whose master finds him doing so when he returns.

Matthew 24:45-46 (NIV) (p.1/3)

Salomon Koninck, "Parable of the Workers in the Vineyard" Hermitage Museum, St. Petersburg. 1648. But suppose that servant is wicked and says to himself, 'My master is staying away a long time,'

and he then begins to **beat** his fellow servants and to **eat** and **drink** with drunkards.

The master of that servant will come on a day when he does not expect him and at an hour he is not aware of.
